

## Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy

The Rediweld Group is committed to acting in a responsible and ethical manner. We have a zero tolerance approach to slavery and human trafficking (“modern slavery.”)

Modern slavery is a crime and a violation of fundamental human rights. It takes various forms, such as slavery, servitude, forced and compulsory labour and human trafficking, all of which have in common the deprivation of a person’s liberty by another in order to exploit them for personal or commercial gain.

Rediweld prohibits the practice of modern slavery in all company operations. We verify that all employees are eligible to work within the group and are paid appropriate wages and salaries.

Rediweld’s prohibition on modern slavery applies to all persons working for the Group or on its behalf in any capacity, and will investigate any claim. If a supplier is found in violation of this policy, Rediweld will take remedial measures to address the violation.

As we have a turnover of less than £36m, Rediweld group is exempt from making a statement on Modern Slavery as we do not fit the criteria defined by HM Government on compliance.
